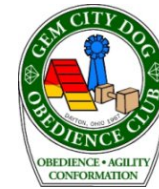

Running order for the trial:

Agility I Divisions 2, 3, 1 (1, 3, 2)	Agility II Divisions 1, 2, 3 (3, 2, 1)
Agility III Divisions 2, 3, 1 (1, 3, 2)	Agility III Divisions 1, 2, 3 (3, 2, 1)
Agility II Divisions 2, 3, 1 (1, 3, 2)	Agility I Divisions 1, 2, 3 (3, 2, 1)

Note: Agility I and Agility II are divided into A and B classes. Agility IA and Agility IIA are for dogs that have not yet earned the respective title. All points for the UACH title must be earned in Agility IB and Agility IIB.

Division I (8" jump height): dogs up to and including 14" at the withers
Division II (14" jump height): dogs over 14" and up to and including 20"
Division III (20" jump height): dogs over 20" at the withers

Reminders:

- Plan to attend the general briefing each day, since all exhibitors and their associates will be responsible for following the instructions given at that time. Failure to attend the briefing does not absolve one from conforming to club rules.
- Please demonstrate good sportsmanship and courtesy both in and out of the ring. Failure to do so may result in your being asked to leave the trial and/or being barred from future trials sponsored by Gem City Dog Obedience Club.
- All entries must be submitted on the current "UKC Entry Form." Please use a separate entry form for each dog. This form can be downloaded from the UKC website (<http://ukcdogs.com/dogevents/forms.shtml>).
- All dogs entering UKC performance events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number. Entries without a valid number will be returned.
- Mail all completed entries to the Trial Secretary and make fees payable to Gem City Dog Obedience Club (GCDOC).

- If you wish to be assigned a special handicapped time for your runs, please indicate this on your entry and be prepared to provide documentation.
- This trial will be held indoors at the Gem City Dog Obedience Club's training building, 1654 Springfield St, Dayton, OH.
- Food will be available at our Paws Café
- According to UKC regulations, all dogs, must wear a plain, buckle collar in the ring. For the on-lead walk throughs, the dog must be on a 6' leash.
- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch in season on the trial date will be refunded the entry fee for that dog less a \$5/day handling fee following receipt of a written certificate from a veterinarian. Notification must be received by the trial secretary by 9 AM on the day of the trial. Initial Email notification is preferable.
- Any handler with a dog that is injured or ill prior to the trial date will be refunded the entry fee for that dog less a \$5/day handling fee under the following conditions: the trial secretary must receive notification by 9 AM on the day of the trial and the trial secretary must be provided with a written certificate from a veterinarian. The entry fee will be refunded for any deceased dog.

Directions to GCDOC, 1654 Springfield St., Dayton, OH: I-75 from the North take SR 4 North, to Harshman Road exit. At the bottom of the ramp turn right, turn left onto Springfield Street. From the South, take I-75 North to First St. and follow above directions. I-70 from the East or West, take SR 4 South to Harshman Road exit. At the bottom of the ramp turn left. Turn left onto Springfield Street. GCDOC is located in the rear of an industrial/warehouse building, on the South side of Springfield Street, opposite an Ohio E-Check facility.
