| | | Monday 6:30:7:30pm | BEGINNER 2/3 Tom Mundey | Dogs must have successfully completed classes through Beginner 1. Builds on skills learned earlier concentrating on independent performances. Instruction in maximizing obstacle performance while adding more complex handling techniques. Must have reliable attention and focus to work off-lead and able to perform all obstacles including at least 6 upright weaves and teeter. | 6 |
| | | Monday 7:30-8:30pm | LATERAL DISTANCE HANDLING Vicki Head/Sherri Heizer | Class for handlers who want to add distance to the dog's performance. Dogs must be able to to independently perform all obstacles. AKC Open thru Masters skill level. | 8 |
| | | Tuesday 10:00-11:00am | SKILLS & DRILLS OPEN/ADVANCED Deb Werts | Requirement: 12 Weaves. Short sequences of 6 to 8 obstacles using rears, fronts, serpentines, etc. Dogs must be experienced and able to independently perform all obstacles. | 6 |
| | | Tuesday 6:30-7:45pm | ADVANCED COMPETITION Yvonne Mancino | Dogs and handlers must have Excellent Level Skills. Class Fee: Members \$150 (or Voucher + additional \$115). | | | Wednesday 11:00am- 12:00pm | NOVICE/OPEN COMPETITION Cherrie Treber | Prerequisite: Classes thru Beginner 3. Instruction for those showing the first levels of competition. Must be able to perform all obstacles including 6 weaves. Skill Level: AKC Novice/Open, CPE Level 4, or equivalent. | 6 |
| | | Wednesday 6:30-7:30pm | INTERMEDIATE HANDLING Mary Holland/Deb Werts | Prerequisite: Must have completed classes through Novice Level. This class is geared toward Open Level dogs and will concentrate on developing handling skills. Dogs must be able to independently perform all obstacles including 12 weaves. | 6 |
| | | Wednesday 7:45-8:45pm | INTRO TO BEGINNER/BEGINNER 1 Kathy Roberts | Prerequisite: Foundation. Dogs and handlers are introduced to agility equipment. Positive reinforcement is used to pattern skills needed to safely and and successfully perform all standard agility obstacles. Beginner 1 teams will continue to work on obstacle behavior including reinforcing independent obstacle performance and focus. Dogs must have a reliable recall and enough focus and attention to work safely off-lead around other dogs. | 6 |
| | | Thursday 6:30-7:30pm | FOUNDATION Mary Beam | This class required prior to starting Intro to Beginner Class. Instruction utilizing fun techniques to promote focus and attention while maintaining drive for future agility training. Teams work on basic agility flatwork. Prior Obedience training above Puppy class required (No Exceptions). | 6 |
| | | Thursday 6:30-7:30pm | NOVICE /OPEN Darlene Miller/Anne-Marie Schuler | Perquisite: Instruction for those showing the first levels of competition. Must be able to perform all obstacles including 6 weaves. Skill Level: AKC Novice, CPE Level 4, or equivalent. | 12 |
| | | Thursday 7:45-8:45pm | MASTERS AGILITY | MUST BE RUNNING TOP LEVEL OF AKC AGILITY. Class will be critiqued through group discussion of handling techniques and ways to improve performances on specific sequences. | 6 |
