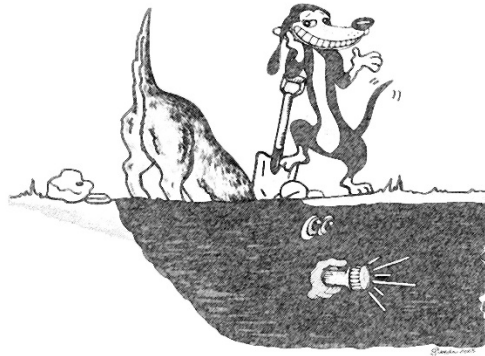

Driving Directions to Emergency Vet:

Turn right leaving grounds. Turn LEFT onto BRANDT. Turn LEFT onto STANLEY AVE. Merge onto OH-4 S toward MIDDLETOWN /I-75. Merge onto I-75 S toward CINCINNATI. Take the Dryden Rd. South exit toward Moraine. At the bottom of the ramp turn RIGHT onto Dryden Rd. First light after going under the highway, turn left. End at 2417 Springboro Rd West Dayton, OH 45439-1722 (on left).

The grounds will open at 7:00 am EDT November 4th. Masters brace draw will be held at 8:45 am. Master judging will begin at 9:00 am. Introduction to Quarry will begin at 10:30 am & Senior judging will begin approximately ½ hour after the conclusion of the Master Class. Junior judging will begin approximately ½ hour after the conclusion of IQ. The Club reserves the right to alter the running order to facilitate the efficient operation of the test.

Entrants should check the gate sheets for running order.

- A ribbon will be awarded to each dog that passes Introduction to Quarry.
- A rosette will be awarded to each dog that qualifies in Junior, Senior or Master

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the Official AKC Entry Forms are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. Unsigned entries or entries with missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned.

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.. **All funds submitted must be in US currency.**

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of no less than \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE: Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without the recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not in the holding area when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate them.

TEST COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for nor will it assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed on the trial site.

REMEMBER: CENTRAL OHIO DACHSHUND CLUB WILL BE HOLDING A SECOND TEST FOLLOWING GEM CITY'S TEST ON NOVEMBER 4TH.

Your entry in future tests may be affected by failure to abide by these rules.

Directions to the site:

NOTE: do **NOT** rely on your GPS directions.

From the North or South or West: I-75 to Stanley Ave. exit (Exit 56A), turn east. From light #1 (Webster St. – Shell gas station) go 4 more lights to Brandt Pike (1.2 miles). Turn left (north) for slightly less than 1 mile. Look for Midwest Trailer Sales on the right. Turn right immediately afterwards onto Valleycrest Dr. Gem City grounds are on the left behind a chain link fence before the residential area. (Note: Probable construction on I-75; check ODOT.org for updated closings.) From I-70, westbound, exit South on State Rt. 4 to Stanley Ave. exit, turn right, go to Brandt Pike, turn right, follow rest of directions above.

The grounds will be available from 5:00 pm EDT Friday, November 3rd. The gates will be closed for security reasons at 9 pm. No hook-ups are available. Anyone dumping on the grounds will be asked to leave. No refund will be given.

Self-contained Motor Homes will be permitted to camp on the grounds. Fee is \$10.00 per night.
