Handlers and dogs will run short sequences of 6 to 8 obstacles using a variety of handling techniques such as backs, rear and front crosses, serpentine, 180's, etc. This class is for you if you and your dog need to gain that last leg in Novice and/or are competing in Open.	10

		Wednesday 5:00-6:00pm	<b>HANDLING SKILLS FOR COMPETITION</b> Sherri Heizer	Class for those in beginning levels of competition. Builds on skills learned earlier concentrating on independent performances. Instruction in maximizing obstacle performance while adding more complex handling techniques. Must have completed Beginner Series and working toward first levels of competition. Dogs must have reliable attention and focus to work off-lead and able to perform all obstacles including at least 6 upright weaves.	6
		Wednesday 6:30-7:30pm	<b>INTERMEDIATE HANDLING</b> Mary Holland/Deb Werts	This class will concentrate on developing handling skills. Dogs <b>must have Excellent Level skills</b> and be able to independently perform all obstacles (including 12 weaves) and have a consistent contact behavior.	6
		Wednesday 7:45-8:45pm	<b>BEGINNER SERIES</b> Suzi Forshey/Susan Stiles	<b>Prerequisite: Foundation.</b> Dogs must have a reliable recall and enough focus and attention to work safely off-lead around other dogs. Positive reinforcement is used to pattern skills needed to safely and successfully perform all standard agility obstacles. This class consists of at least 3 Sessions. Instructors will work with each team to build skills in obstacle behavior, independent obstacle performance, and finally building handling skills for short 1-2 obstacle sequences. <b>Dogs ready to move on must be focused, under control, be able to independently perform 6 upright weaves, and have a consistent contact behavior.</b>	10
		Thursday 6:30-7:30pm	<b>FOUNDATION</b> Mary Beam	<b>This class required prior to starting Intro to Agility Class.</b> Instruction utilizing fun techniques to promote focus and attention while maintaining drive for future agility training. Teams work on basic agility flatwork. Prior Obedience training above Puppy class required ( <b>No Exceptions</b> ).	5
		Thursday 6:30-7:30pm	<b>HANDLING SKILLS FOR COMPETITION</b> Terri Hendrix/Anne-Marie Walkowicz	Class for those in beginning levels of competition. Builds on skills learned earlier concentrating on independent performances. Instruction in maximizing obstacle performance while adding more complex handling techniques. Must have completed Beginner Series and working toward first levels of competition. Dogs must have reliable attention and focus to work off-lead and able to perform all obstacles including at least 6 upright weaves.	10
