Nose work and competition class had increased enrollments. There are 96 students registered for the beginner/puppy obedience classes. Agility has 96 students in 15 classes. There was a new foundation class added this session.

Obedience: Kristina Morgan. Absent. Angela will talk to Kristina about spacing the classes further apart. It becomes too crowded with one class ending and another beginning at the same time.

Agility: Sherri Heizer. Classes full. Trial went well.

New Business.

Agility Instructor Issue

There was an issue with an agility instructor being rude to a student and the foundation instructor. The student's husband was watching agility foundation with another dog which was not in the class. The agility foundation instructor gave her permission. The student sent a message to the club that the agility instructor coming in proceeded to be rude to her husband telling him he was not allowed to be there and she was rude to the foundation instructor and hurrying her to finish and clear the class out.

In the boards discussions about this it was determined that since there is 15 minutes between classes the second agility instructor should not have been hurrying the foundation instructor. There currently is no written rule that states a family member with another dog cannot watch a class. This is up to instructor discretion. Sherrie Heizer talked with the second agility instructor and apologized to the foundation instructor for the incident. It was discussed that a formal apology should be written by the club to the student involved.

There was an issue in another agility class where one dog attacked another dog. The victimized dog had to go to the vet but appears to be getting better. The individuals involved did not feel it warranted a formal incident report to be submitted. After a board discussion, it was concluded that the instructor should submit an incident report.

Land Issue

The EPA is closing the valley crest landfill by the land owned by Gem City. They are proposing closing the road that now leads to the land since it is privately owned and opening up a new road. This may involve the closure of the front entrance and the need to use the back entrance. A meeting has been scheduled and Kathy Roberts and Pam Murn will attend.

Obedience Sheets

There has been no obedience sheets or certificates in the files for the classes that ended in session 1. It was decided that the sheets for the lessons could be made electronically and emailed to the students. The instructors would like to hand out certificates on the last night. Angela will talk to Kristina about this issue.

On May 14 and 15 Aullwood is have an event and would like some members to volunteer to do an obedience or agility demo.
