Board Members Present: Steve Hart, Kathy Roberts, Sherri Heizer, Donna Jennings, Maggie Melton, Barb Siler, John Clifford, Alecia Heidorn, Tami Woodrow

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 7:29 pm by Steve Hart. Motion to accept meeting minutes from 8/7/22 was made by Sherri Heizer and seconded by Maggie Melton. Motion passed.

Vice President: Steve Hart. Canine Dog Club is looking to rent the building. Steve needs to get more information on the date.

Membership: Tami Woodrow. See attached membership report of hours volunteered for each member. Some members need hours by the end of September to qualify for membership the next year. Every member must have at least 20 volunteer hours. Instructors are not turning in their rosters with the number of hours they taught. An email will be sent reminding members they need hours and instructors to turn in their hours.

Treasurer: Kathy Roberts. See attachment. There is \$100,918,59 in checking/savings. We had some large expenses this month. A new backdoor was installed, and the parking lot was repaved. Sherrie made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Tami seconded. Motion passed.

Registrar: Maggie Melton. Agility schedule is ready. Waiting on obedience schedule. Kristina Morgan asked to be removed as obedience director. Maggie is not sure she has a schedule, if not, the same schedule as this session will be offered. A new director will need to be appointed. Registration needs to open soon because Thursday classes will not be held the first week of the session due to the agility trial. Rally/obedience will need to meet a week earlier on Sept. 29th.

Conformation: No director

Obedience: Kristina Morgan. Absent. Stepping down as obedience director. Obedience and rally trial scheduled for Sept. 24th and 25th is full.

Agility: Sherri Heizer. A foundation class is being added to the schedule. It will be on Wednesdays at 5 pm. The agility trial scheduled for Oct. 7,8, and 9 is full.

Maintenance Report: John Clifford. See attachment for full details. Sherri made a motion to approve the spending of 950-1000 for Korrect plumbing to clean the main line on the south side of the building. Kathy seconded. Motion passed.

The board gave John permission to have the drain tile dug up and replaced in the back of the building, clean out the gutters and have outside lights installed. The cost will be approximately 1800.00.

Kathy made a motion to conditionally approve a quote for 10, 500 to replace the 70 light fixtures in the agility room with 60 LED fixtures with lens covers. The condition is the Kathy, Maggie and Sherrie will

need to see the quote and make sure the light fixtures are facing up when installed. Maggie seconded. Motion passed. John proposed that the old light fixtures be sold.

After a discussion on the improvements which are needed to the front of the building, it was decided to table any major improvements for now and to just spray the weeds.

John needs volunteers to install the new dog poop containers for outside. It was decided that they would be placed in a bucket of cement so they can be moved if necessary. There are two more bag holders that can be attached to the wall outside.

John also needs volunteers to scrape the back park lot. The idea of having another volunteer weekend was discussed and John said he would look at his schedule.

It is possible to have cameras with remote capability. This may be investigated.

Board Meeting - BUILDING MAINTENANCE REPORT

- September 11, 2022
- The plywood around the new back door has been painted with a second coat. Thanks Steve!
- 2. HVAC duct cleaning and sealing. Planned for the week between classes. Sept 20-22 (Tu-W-Th). While they are in there (8am to 5pm), the building needs to be closed due to noise and equipment. Evenings should be OK. <u>Cost \$3500</u>
- 3. We have plans to better balance the temperature between the two rooms as well as some added air flow. Working on quotes.
- 4. The plan to installing new light fixtures to replace lights on the outside of the building with new, brighter lights. Installation to be by October. Cost for the eight fixtures will be \$1200. Order to be placed by 9/23.
- 5. I had Korrect Plumbing to see if the drain tiles on the south side of the building can be opened like we had done on the north side. It turns out the main line is blocked and will need to be cleared out with a water jet. <u>Cost approx. \$950 \$1000</u>.
- 6. I have a quote for digging up and replacing the drain tile in back of the building, cleaning out the gutters, installing outside lights and some other work on the back hillside. <u>Cost would be \$1800</u>. This should fix the rest of the water drain issues. Target would be mid-October.
- 7. We have a quote to upgrade the lighting in the turf room. It would require replacing the current 70 fixtures with new 60 LED fixture with lens covers. Overall lighting level will be improved. <u>Cost for fixtures is \$10,500</u>. Installation TBD.
- 8. Improvements to the front (facing the street) of the building. Proposal to level off the area and replace the RR ties with blocks would require moving dirt and pulling out old stumps. Concern is the height and possible need for a railing. Looking for quotes. Or just spray weeds and leave it be.
- 9. Volunteer project: The back parking lot still needs to be scraped/shoveled off to remove the weeds and silt from rains.
- 10. Volunteer project: The club has new dog poop containers for outside that need to be installed. Old ones dug up, put new ones installed using a bucket of cement.
