

Agility: Deb Werts. She bought a leaf blower for the turf. Sherie is looking for tunnels, the tunnels we have now are very worn. There's an agility trial on Aug. 12 and 13.

Maintenance Report: John Clifford. See attached report. He will be meeting this Friday with Barnes wildlife expert to investigate how the birds are getting into the agility room. The semi-annual HVAC inspection is also scheduled for this Friday. Steve Hart made a motion to approve 3100.00 for resealing the blacktop driveway, Maggie Melton seconded. Motion passed. John will try to find a time that does not interfere with classes and trials. Painting of the outside of the building was discussed. It was decided that a second quote should be obtained before any decisions are made.

He does not believe it would be a good idea with members sitting in that area. It was mentioned that more shelving is being stored at the land, these might possibly work. We need to decide exactly what we want to store on any new shelves we put in the facility.

to the city of Dayton. Tammi Woodrow seconded the motion. The motion passed. A vote was made, and this small section of land will be given to the city of Dayton. The resolution will be typed up and all the board members must sign it.

Board Meeting - BUILDING MAINTENANCE REPORT: June 11, 2023

- 1) Sealing of the new blacktop on the parking lot and restriping: \$3100
- 2) Install a water bottle filling station: working on quote.
- 3) Quote to paint the outside of the building from Dba GrimeBusters (full disclosure: Steve Hart's wife business):
 - a) Front Block section only \$8,350
 - b) Whole building \$21,950
- 4) Work session for hours:
 - a) Drop ceiling tiles
 - b) Fill in from neighbor's dog holes
 - c) Cut down weeds out back
 - d) Dig up and replace dog poop receptacles.
 - e) Clear brush from hill
 - f) Downspout connections in back.
 - g) Put up signs to "pick up after your dog"
- 5) Second person "no quoted" on the concrete pad outside of the back door. I need to make more calls. Estimate this to be \$2500.
- 6) I have a quote of \$3500 on cutting down and removing 2 walnut trees on the hill on the south side, including grinding out stumps and hauling wood away.
- 7) Bird issue I have Barnes Wildlife Control scheduled to give <u>assessment</u> (\$310), quote to follow.
- 8) Semi-annual HVAC inspection, filters, belts \$900.
- 9) Plan to investigate reducing the platform holding the HVAC air handler system.
- 10) Install a few more video cameras
