Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 7:16 pm by Michelle Collet. The motion to accept the minutes from 10/15/24 and 11/2/24 was made by Alecia Heidorn and seconded by Bar Siler. Motion carried.

President: Michelle Collett. We need to fill the member at large position which she previously held before becoming president. Kathy Roberts made a motion to fill the open member at large position with Angela Profit. Steve Hart seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The annual banquet has been set for February 8th. The theme will be the Canine Cabaret. Information will be sent to the members in an email.

Vice President: Steve Hart. Greenville dog would like a one-day rental in the spring and fall. Steve will get the dates to see if the building is available. Ellen Manns of the Curly Coated Retriever Club of America would like to rent the Northcutt building in 2027 for their national specialty. This would be a Monday thru Thursday rental for rally and conformation. They have not given dates. Steve will look at the calendar and see what if any available options might fit their schedule. Some suggested that they may also want to look into other local clubs to see their availability.

Mary Faulkner would like to rent the land to train on a needed basis. This was declined. The land is too busy at this point to allow this. She would need exact times and dates to see if there is availability.

Membership: Tami Woodrow. Absent

Treasurer: Kathy Roberts. See attached report. The club has \$203,986.58 in bank accounts. The income is up this year Anyone can see the books, just get in contact with Kathy. Motion to accept the treasurers report was made by Angela Profit and seconded by Alecia Heidorn. Motion carried.

Registrar: Maggie Melton. There are still ongoing complaints and problems with online registration. Barb Siler suggested forming a committee to seek information from professional companies on developing a more user-friendly site. After receiving proposals and information the committee could determine if it is a feasible option for the club. The board agreed this is a good idea. Barb Siler will chair the committee and report back at the next board meeting.

Obedience: Kristina Morgan. Absent. The new obedience jumps have arrived and Angela Profitt assembled them. They are only going to be used for trials. There will be an obedience and rally trial in June, 2025.

Agility: Deb Werts. See attached report. Deb would like to purchase a Clip and Go A Frame for the club for the club. The cost is \$3,320.00 but the \$2570.00 earned during the sale at the land. The difference would be \$750.00. Barb Siler made a motion to allow Deb to purchase the Clip and Go A-Frame. Maggie Melton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Deb is going to form a committee to look at and possibly revise the standing rules as they apply to agility. The guidelines for agility need to be updated. The board agreed.

Lori Zakel would like to use the turf room on Dec. 29th from 5:30 to 7 for the 4-H club.

Old Business

Land Sports Director

The nominating committee made a recommendation to create a new position of Land Sports Director and eliminate Confirmation Director. It was pointed out that in order to do this we would need to change the By-laws and that is a huge undertaking. It was decided that rather than having a director, a better position would be a liaison to serve as a bridge between the board and the sports going on at the land. This person could present the lands proposals and information as a report at board meetings on an as needed basis. The board agreed to this and will look into a person to fill this position. They will also look to see if anyone is interested in running conformation run throughs, which was stopped due to COVID.
